- Impact of Law Enforcement on Your Life and Community: How has law enforcement influenced your life or the lives of those around you? Discuss specific instances where law enforcement made a significant impact in your community or your personal life.
- Vision for the Future of Law Enforcement: Considering the current social climate, how do you
 envision the future of law enforcement? What role do you believe you could play in fostering a
 positive relationship between law enforcement and the community?

Also, explain how rec<mark>eiving</mark> the Presidential Scholarship will assist you in achieving your educational and career aspirations.

Your response should be thoughtful, reflective, and demonstrate a genuine understanding of the importance of law enforcement in our society. We encourage you to share personal stories, experiences, and insights that will give us a deeper understanding of your character and commitment to making a positive impact in your community.



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Lodge #41 Presidential Scholarship Application

- 1. Evidence of current school enrollment or acceptance.
- 2. Transcripts of previous coursework, if any.
- 3. Copy of course curriculum for degree being sought.
- 4. Provide a copy of FOP Lodge 41 Membership Card & Law Enforcement Credentials
- 5. Submit an Essay describing a situation where you took on a leadership role. What was the outcome, the impact on those around you, and what did you learn about leading others?

 **Essay must be in APA Format & up to two pages maximum.

SCHOLARSHIP RULES and GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The application must be complete with all attachments provided and submitted to the Gainesville Hall County, Fraternal Order of Police, at the below listed address.
- 2. Applications must be submitted by Nov 1st to be reimbursed for the Fall Semester.
- 3. This Scholarship is for a maximum of \$1,000.00. Scholarship funds will be paid on a reimbursement basis. A copy of the paid tuition receipt along with evidence of successful completion of coursework must be submitted to the scholarship committee chairman prior to disbursement of funds. A minimum grade of "C" must be attained for tuition expenses to be reimbursable.
- 4. Non-credit courses will not be reimbursed. Only those courses, which apply toward the attainment of the stated degree, are reimbursable.
- 5. Reimbursable coursework must be completed within twelve months following the Scholarship effective date.
- 6. Applicant must be an immediate family member of a current/retired law enforcement officer of an agency within Hall County.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- 1. The committee will consider all information submitted by the application making its selection.
- 2. Applicants seeking their first degree will be given priority over those seeking secondary or graduate degrees.
- 3. New applicants will be given priority over previous recipients of this scholarship.
- 4. The Scholarship Committee will select and notify the Scholarship recipients by December 1st.
